Eligibility-The students of Class 6 to 8 of CBSE-affiliated schools across country (except KVS, NVS) may voluntarily participate.

Illustrate the cultural diversity and harmony fostered through the Maha Kumbh Mela

Awards and Prizes in each Category [(i) Dawing and (ii) Painting] at All India Level

- First Prize -INR 15,000/-
- Second Prize INR 10,000/-
- Third Prize INR 7,000/-
- 10 Consolation prizes each comprising a certificate and a gift hamper

Submission of the Shortlisted Entry by Schools to CBSE:

GUIDELINES

All India Maha Kumbh Drawing and Painting Contest for Students, 2025

I. Eligibility-The contest is open to students of Class 6 to 8 in CBSE-affiliated schools across country (except KVS and JNV).

II.Themes for the Contest

• Bhavya Maha Kumbh:

Depict the spiritual magnificence and vibrant atmosphere of the Maha Kumbh & the Sacred Confluence of Ganga, Yamuna, and Sarawati at Prayagraj

• Divya Maha Kumbh:

Showcase the traditions, rituals and ceremonies associated with Maha Kumbh Mela

• Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat:

Illustrate the cultural diversity and harmony fostered through the Maha Kumbh Mela

III. Rules and Regulations for Schools

- 1. Categories for Submission: Entries may be submitted under following two categories
 - Drawing
 - Painting
- 2. Only bonafide students (enrolled in the specified classes) are allowed to participate.
- 3. The Drawing or Painting must be the original creation of the student.
- 4. Each student can submit only one entry, in either Drawing or Painting.
- 5. Each school can submit a maximum of 6 best entries (three in Drawing and three in Painting).
- 6. For each entry, students must mention the theme and provide a title/caption for the artwork.
- 7. Students must mention their name, school name, affiliation number, complete postal address, and contact details (Mobile/WhatsApp number) on the artwork.
- 8. Entries should be submitted through the Head of the School along with a certificate of authenticity in the prescribed format.
- 9. All entries will be screened by the school's jury before submission.
- 10. Schools will be asked to submit selected entries in original and the submitted entries will not be returned.
- 11. Selected entries will be displayed in an exhibition and compiled into a booklet.
- 12. CBSE/NCERT reserves the right and copyright to use the artworks for educational purposes (in print and digital formats).
- 13. In all disputes, the decision of the Director/Joint Director, CIET/NCERT, New Delhi will be final and binding.

IV. Acceptable specification for contest:

1. Drawing:

Can be done in monochrome, any medium such as Pen & ink, Pencil, Charcoal or any single colour.

2. Painting:

Painting should be colourful, done in any medium such as water colour, poster colour, oil pastel, colour pencil, acrylic and combination of these

Note: The maximum size of the art work should not be more than full imperial cartridge sheet size 22"X30".

V. Judging Criteria - Evaluation of Art work, at school level, should be based on the following-

- Relevance to the theme
- Creativity and originality
- Aesthetic Sensibilityof artwork
- Overall impact

VI. Awards and Prizes in each category at All India Level

- First Prize -INR 15,000/-
- Second Prize INR 10,000/-
- Third Prize INR 7,000/-
- 10 Consolation prizes each comprising a certificate and a gift hamper

VII. Submission guidelines -

- File Name of artwork should be saved in following format: Student Name, Class and School Code
- Check Annexure II for detailed submission instructions

VIII. Entry Free

No fee is charged for participation.

IX. Important Dates and Mode of participation

- The schools may organize competition at school level for selecting 6 best entries i.e., three from Drawing and three from Painting and upload in the CBSE MahaKumbh APP available in Google App Store from 30th January, 2025.
- Please upload the duly filled in forms given below along with the Drawing/Painting selected at school level in JPG (Maximum size can be 2MB).

NOTE-

- Incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- Keep the original copy of the selected entries in the school safely till the declaration of the result.
- The decision of the evaluation committee shall be final and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.


Uploading of Entries through APP


MahaKumbh Android App Usage Details: -

Requirement: Android smart phone having operating system version 5.0 and above with internet connectivity.



- 2. Tap on the "CBSE Mahkumbh" icon to launch the App and follow the steps given below:






