No. HQ-PPII010/1/2024-PP_II: The candidates may please refer to the Notice of Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2024 (CHSLE-2024) published by the Commission on its website on 08.04.2024. The Commission conducted the CHSLE-2024 (Tier-I) from 01.07.2024 to 11.07.2024 in the Computer Based Mode and the result of Tier-I was declared on 06.09.2024. The Commission conducted the CHSLE-2024 (Tier-II) on 18.11.2024 in the Computer Based Mode. The Commission *vide* Notice, dated 26.11.2024, has also informed the candidates that the Option-cum-Preference would be taken before the declaration of final result of the aforesaid exam.

Before declaration of the final result, Option-cum-Preference(s) for post(s)/Department(s) 2. are required to be submitted by those candidates who have appeared in Tier-II examination. Accordingly, all candidates, who have appeared in Tier-II, are advised to submit their Option-cum-Preference for post(s)/Department(s) for CHSLE-2024 through their respective 'CANDIDATE LOGIN' on the website of SSC (Headquarters) i.e., https://ssc.gov.in wherein facility for submission of Option-cum-Preference for Post(s)/Organization(s) will be available under Mv Application Tab, which will remain active during the period from 04.02.2025 (06:00 PM) to 08.02.2025 (11:59 PM). Further, a confirmation email will also be sent to candidate's registered email after completion of process of submission of Option-cum-Preference. It is made clear that physical submission of Option-cum-Preference for Post(s)/Organization(s) from a candidate will not be accepted in any case.

3. Candidates may please note that the Option-cum-Preference(s) can be revised only during the aforesaid period and Option-cum-Preference(s) last submitted by the candidate will be treated as final. **Candidates must ensure that after filling their preference, they must submit the form by clicking the "Submit" button**. Candidates who fail to exercise their Option-cum-Preference(s) during the aforesaid period, shall not be given any further opportunity in any circumstances for submission of their Option-cum-Preference(s) and such candidates will not be considered for inclusion in the final merit list/final selection. Therefore, it is mandatory for all the candidates who have appeared in Tier-II to exercise their Option-cum-Preference(s) for consideration of their candidature in the final merit list/final selection in CHSLE-2024.

4. PwBD candidates must ensure that they give preference for only those posts which are identified as suitable for their disabilities. Allocation of posts will be made as per the provisions of the Notice of Examination on the basis of 'merit-cum-preference of posts'. The candidature of a PwBD

candidate will get cancelled by the User Department concerned if he/ she gets selected for a post that is not identified as suitable for his/ her disabilities.

5. All candidates are requested to ensure that they fulfill the requisite Physical and Medical Standards for the post before submitting the preference form. The candidature of a candidate may get cancelled by the User Department concerned if he/ she gets selected for a post and later on, found he/she doesn't meet the requisite Physical and/or Medical Standards of the post(s).

6. It is reiterated that the candidates will not be provided any further opportunity for the exercising their Option-cum-Preference beyond the dates mentioned above. Any grievance received in this regard in any form like Post, Fax, Email, by hand, etc. will not been entertained by the Commission.
